### Workshop on Stochastic and Uneven-Aged Structured Models in Forest Economics

Helsinki, Finland October 8 - 9, 2004

#### Topics

The aim of this international workshop is to promote economic analysis of vital topics in forest economics. In keynote lectures special attention is devoted to stochastic rotation analysis and to extending current approaches to uneven-aged structures in forests. The subject of the contributed papers will range over all relevant topics. The workshop time table will provide plenty of time for official and unofficial discussion.
